Thursday 13th: Mrs Murphy's Class will have their sports day at 11.00am. Children will go home afterwards with a packed lunch.


Friday 14th: Mrs Mallon's Class will have their sports day at 11.00am. Children will go home afterwards with a packed lunch.


#### Open Day 2019 - 2020


Monday 17th: Children will finish at 11.30am to allow staff to prepare the classrooms for the Open Afternoon for children starting nursery in September 2019.


